Criteria for the award

Chapter chairs will administer the nomination process using the criteria outlined on the nomination form.

1. All nominations will be submitted to the chapter member appointed to this committee.
2. Each chapter chair will submit to the DKGVT Chair 8 copies of the nomination with the letters of reference as designated on the nomination form.
3. A nomination must be made by a member of DKGVT.
4. Nominee may be a leader of a youth group, but his/her responsibility should be an avocation, not a vocation.
5. A nominee may be a parent, guardian, or foster parent.
6. A nomination not getting the award may be resubmitted.
7. The chapter will be responsible for escorting the recipient to the Spring Convention.
8. Deadline for receiving nominations is December 15.
