

Sock Snowmen

For this craft, you'll need a pair of new men size socks that are crew length, or longer.



First, cut off the top of the sock from the foot.



Put foot part of sock to the side.

Turn the top of the sock inside out and attach a rubber band tightly to the top of the sock.

I also tied a string around it in case rubber band breaks with time.

Then turn the sock right-side out again.





Fill the sock with 3 or more tablespoons of pebbles.

Make sure to pack it down so the sock gets a nice round base.

Then fill the rest with polyfil.



Rubber band the top of the sock closed, also tie with string. Put another rubber band 3/4 of the way to the top for the head of your snowman.



Now, decorate! Tie a scarf around your snowman's neck and add eyes, nose, and buttons. I used map pins for my eyes. Unfortunately, I didn't have any black ones, so I colored purple ones with sharpie and stuck them in. Dab tacky glue on pins as you insert them and let dry so they don't fall out later



Use the toe of your cut socks to fashion a stocking cap





You can either sew or glue on your buttons, and add embellishments - twine, bows, ribbons, etc - as needed.
